

Sperm autoantibodies

General:

Due to extravasally floating sperm, caused by trauma, occlusions or by inflammatory processes, the contact of the immune system with sperm can result in the formation of sperm antibodies. They have agglutinating and immobilizing qualities. They can be an important cause for infertility if they occur in high concentrations and interfere with the cervical mucus penetration of the spermatozoa.

Material: 1 ml serum, seminal fluid

TAT: 3 days, FML

Method: Latex agglutination

Units: Titer

Ref.- range: see report

Note: If possible both partners should be examined
