General:

Sultiame (also known as Sulthiame) is a sulfonamide and inhibitor of the enzyme carbonic anhydrase. It is used as an anticonvulsant and is the drug of choice for benign focal epilepsies of childhood such as benign rolandic epi-lepsy.

Material: 1 ml serum

TAT: 7-10 days*

Method: HPLC

Units: mg/l

Ref.- range: 0 - 15 years : 1.0 - 6.0 > 15 years : 6.0 - 10.0
