

Androstenediol glucuronide

General:

Androstenediol glucuronide is a marker for the peripheral androgen conversion of the skin and hair follicles. The test is useful for the diagnosis of hirsutism and other disturbances with a high level of androgen production, especially in the case where other androgens were not detected with any significance. Decreased levels of androstenediol glucuronide can be associated with a risk of prostate carcinoma.

Material: 1 ml serum

TAT: 7-10 days*

Method: EIA
