

# Hair loss

<b>Endocrine</b>	Hyperthyroidism, hypothyroidism, hypopituitarism, parathyroidism, virilism or drug related (anticonception with a strong progesterone component), postmenopausal as a result of a relative androgen surplus
<b>Toxic</b>	Thallium
<b>Drug related</b>	Cytostatics, anticoagulants, thyreostatics, substances with effect on lipid metabolism, antiepileptics, antifungal drugs, antimalarial drugs
<b>Infectious</b>	Influenza, typhoid fever, lues, tuberculosis
<b>Others</b>	Collagenosis (scleroderma, lupus erythematodes), iron deficiency (hypermenorrhea), protein deficiency diet (Kwashiorkor), neoplasia, cirrhosis, vitamin deficiency (vitamin A, D, E and F, folic acid, B12), magnesium deficiency, zinc deficiency, post-operative, mechanical, synthesis defect in hair growth (e.g. at aminoaciduria, homocystinuria, orotaciduria, phenylketonuria)
