



Intercellular substance autoantibodies

General:

Synonyms: epidermal basement membrane antibody, intercellular substance autoantibody, pemphigus antibody, pemphigoid antibody. The presence of antibodies against epidermal intercellular substance is typical for pemphigus vulgaris (PV), a severe chronic and serious disease of skin and mucous membranes. In bullous pemphigoid, circulating antibodies are seen in approx. 70% (mostly IgG type).

The following tests are available:

• Epidermal basal membrane antibodies

- Indication: DD other bullous dermatoses, e.g. bullous pemphigoid, IgA-pemphigoid, herpes gestationis
- Material: 1 ml serum
 - TAT: 7-10 days*
- Method: IFT
 - Units: titer
- Ref.- range: <1:10
