

Leukocyte Elastase

General:

The leukocyte elastase concentration in seminal fluid is considered to be a significant and sensitive parameter in inflammations or asymptomatic inflammations of the male genital tract, such as prostatitis, epidyditis, urethritis. Please note that acute inflammations of the distal urethra can also show high elastase values in the seminal fluid by contaminating leukocytes.

Indication: Inflammation of genital tract in men

Material: 1 ml seminal fluid

TAT: 7-10 days*

Method: EIA

Units: $\mu\text{g/l}$
