

Nitrazepam

General:

As with clonazepam and diazepam, nitrazepam belongs to the group of tranquillizers and is a derivative of the benzodiazepines. It is applied in epileptic disorders and is particularly used for the treatment of myoclonic disorders.

Indication:

Therapy monitoring

The following tests are available:

- **Nitrazepam in serum**

Material: 1 ml serum

TAT: 5-7 days*

Method: LCMS

Units: µg/l

Ref.- range: 40 – 180

- **Nitrazepam in urine, qualitative[^]**

Material: 10 ml urine

TAT: same day, FML

Method: IA

Units: qualitative

Ref.- range: negative

- **Nitrazepam in urine, quantitative**

Material: 10 ml urine

TAT: 5-7 days, *

Method: LCMS

Units: µg/l

Ref.- range: see report
