

# Rheumatic disorders

## General:

Recommended examinations: anti-CCP, Antistaphylolysin test, antistreptolysin test, ANA, CRP, HLA-B27, rheumatoid factor, antibody against yersinia, borrelia, salmonellae, TPHA, acute phase proteins such as CRP

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| <b>Rheumatoid arthritis, RA, PcP</b>  | Special forms:   |
|   | <i>Caplan syndrome</i> (RA+ silicosis),  |
|   | <i>Sjoegren syndrome</i> (RA+keratoconjunctivitis sicca + reduced salivary gland secretion + reduced sweat secretion, xerodermia),   |
|   | <i>Felty syndrome</i> (heavy progressive form of the RA in adulthood),   |
|   | juvenile rheumatoid arthritis (Still syndrome, seronegative polyarthritis), oligoarthritis in early childhood, (oligoarthritis HLA-B27-associated)                                     |
| <b>Collagenoses</b>   | SHARP syndrome, scleroderma, SLE, Sjoegren syndrome, polymyositis and dermatomyositis  |
| <b>seronegative spondyl- arthritis, SPA, HLA-B27-associates, missing rheumatoid factors</b> | M. Bechterew, psoriasis arthritis with sacroileitis, enteropathic arthritidae in M. Crohn, colitis ulcerosa, M. Whipple, M. Reiter, M. Behcet, vasculitis, cristal arthropathy (gout). |
| <b>infectious arthropathies</b>   | Salmonellosis, gonorrhea, lues, yersiniosis, Chlamydia, MTb  |
