

Vigabatrin

General:

Vigabatrin is an antiepileptic drug. It is an irreversible inhibitor of 4- aminobutyrate transaminase, the enzyme responsible for the catabolism of gamma-aminobutyric acid (GABA). It is an analog of GABA, but it is not a receptor agonist. Vigabatrin is chemically unrelated to other anticonvulsants.

Material: 1 ml serum

TAT: 5-7 days*
